What We're Learning

Along with working on our IEP goals, we will be:

Math: We will be working on our IEP goals during work groups and on counting and number skills!

Writing: We will be working on writing our letters and our names.

Social Studies: We will work on Civic standards, including identifying reasons for rules and identifying roles of the school staff We will also start our unit on American symbols!
